

What is Hybrid and how do Members get a ticket to Wolfe Hall?

First, Hybrid means our Senior Scholars speaker presentations are once again live in Wolfe Hall *AND* being streamed to your home via Zoom. As always, when the speaker gives permission, recorded speaker presentations are available on the [website](#) to review at your own convenience.

Second, following are some of the questions, and answers, we assume you have. If we have not covered your questions, please [contact us](#). We will respond and update this FAQ.

Q1: What exactly do I need to have in my possession, at the door, of Providence United Methodist Church?

A1: You will need:

- 1) A 2022 Membership card,
- 2) [Proof of full vaccination status](#) completed a minimum of two (2) weeks prior to that Friday date (either the card or a clear photo of the card),
- 3) A printed ticket, an image of the ticket or the ticket open on your phone confirming your registration. If you arrive without proof you registered we will have a printout of registered persons and can validate your registration.
- 4) and a mask.

We ask that you not show up at Wolfe Hall without ALL 4 of these as without them we must deny you entry.

If you have been recently diagnosed with COVID, are ill, experiencing COVID symptoms or have been recently exposed to a person suffering from COVID, we ask that you stay home and attend by Zoom

We suggest as well that before attending an in-person meeting you consult with your healthcare professional.

Q2: How do I register for in-person speakers beginning January 2022?

A2: Click the in-person button to attend in Wolfe Hall. You will be redirected to a commonly used ticketing service – Eventbrite (you do not need to join Eventbrite). You will be able to order up to two (2) tickets for each session and

will be asked to fill in the contact information for both attendees – including the 2022 Membership number for each attendee. When you submit your request, you'll receive an email from Eventbrite. The email will include a ticket (or tickets) you can print out or send to your smartphone. (If neither option is open to you, Membership will have a list of registered members, and your registration can be checked at Wolfe Hall).

Q3: I renewed and don't have my 2022 Membership Card. What do I do?

A3: If you don't have your 2022 Membership card by January 3, 2022 [contact us](#).

Q4: I am a 2022 member, can I bring a guest with me to Wolfe Hall?

A4: To give the largest number of 2022 members the opportunity to attend in-person we are currently restricting in-person attendance to 2022 members only.

Q5: I haven't renewed my membership for 2022 – do I still have time?

A5: Yes please do! We hope you do so in 2021 so you renew at \$20 but if not, the renewal rate is \$25 and still a bargain for the quality of speakers available to members.

Q6: How many 2022 members can attend at Wolfe Hall?

A6: January 14 the attendance is limited to 150 of our 2022 members. Watch your emails and the website for updates as that number is expected to increase.

Q7: Do I need to bring my vaccination status to every in-person meeting?

A7: At your first in-person meeting your 2022 Membership card will be marked with your vaccination status so that at future meetings you need only bring your 2022 Membership card, a ticket and your mask.

Q8: Will coffee &/or tea be available in Wolfe Hall? If not, can I bring my own beverage in a spill proof container?

A8: Sorry, not at this time.

Q9: Can I renew my membership, in-person, at PUMC?

A9: Not until further notice. Check the website for updates as that will change. To start, the Membership Committee will assist member check in rather than working at the Membership Desk.

Q10: It's 2022 and I haven't renewed yet, can I still attend speaker presentations in-person?

A10: In an abundance of caution, and to support new check in procedures, we are re-opening in Wolfe Hall at a limited capacity. For this reason 2022 Members only can register for in-person. We encourage all others to register to view the speaker, live, on Zoom.

Q11: Has Zoom registration changed?

A11: No, there are no changes in the registration process – click the “Zoom” button and complete the registration as you have in the past. You'll receive an email from Senior Scholars, via Zoom, containing the URL you need to click on to join the meeting.
