Returning to Wolfe Hall for In-Person Meetings

Updated 7/2/2022

Will attendees at Fall in-person meetings be required to wear masks and present proof of vaccination?

Undetermined at present (as of 7-2-2022). The Senior Scholars Board of Directors will meet in late August to decide if any changes should be made to our COVID Safety Protocols (including mask and vaccination requirements) for Fall meetings based on COVID status at that time. The Board's decision will be communicated to members in an email and posted on the website prior to the September 9, 2022 meeting. Answers to questions below are based on our existing protocols and procedures and may be modified following the Board's decision in late August.

Will I need to register in advance and present a ticket to attend in-person meetings at Wolfe Hall in Providence United Methodist Church?

No. Members must present a 2022 Membership Card and guests must check-in at the Membership Desk. Both members and guests will need to follow the COVID Safety Protocols below.

What is Hybrid and what are the requirements for attendance in Wolfe Hall?

First, Hybrid means our Senior Scholars speaker presentations are once again live in Wolfe Hall AND being streamed to your home via Zoom. As always, when the speaker gives permission, recorded speaker presentations are available on the website to review at your own convenience.

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FAQ (cont)

COVID Safety Protocols and what exactly do I need to have in my possession, at the door, of Providence United Methodist Church?

We have in place COVID Safety Protocols for admission to the Church. Please be advised, for the safety of everyone inside PUMC, there are no exceptions made for those medically unable to be vaccinated or unable to wear a mask.

COVID Safety Protocols (for all members and guests)

You will need:

- 1) Proof of vaccination status (including a booster shot), completed a minimum of two weeks prior to that Friday date (either the card or a clear photo of the card). If a member, you can present your 2022 Membership Card that has been previously marked to show proof of full vaccination status.
- 2) A mask. (NOTE: we will have a limited number of masks available if you forget yours.)

We ask that you not show up at Wolfe Hall without these two items. Without proof of full vaccination status or refusal to wear a mask, we must deny you entry.

If you have been recently diagnosed with COVID, are ill, experiencing COVID symptoms or have been recently exposed to a person suffering from COVID, we ask that you stay home and attend by Zoom.

We suggest as well that before attending an in-person meeting you consult with your healthcare professional.



FAQ (cont)

I have lost my 2022 Membership Card and want to attend an in-person meeting. What do I do?

If you can't find your 2022 Membership Card, please go to [Request Member ID](#). You will receive an email with your Member ID which you can present for entrance. You will also need to show proof of full vaccination status. Please stop by the Membership Desk to have a replacement card issued and marked to show proof of full vaccination status.

I am a 2022 member. Can I bring a guest with me to Wolfe Hall?

Yes. Guests are welcome but must meet the COVID Safety Protocols above and stop by the Membership Desk to check-In before the meeting.

I haven't renewed my membership for 2022 – do I still have time and can I do it in-person?

Yes, please do! The renewal rate is \$25. You can renew in-person at the Membership Desk which opens April 29, 2022, or online at [Membership Renewal](#).

Do I need to bring proof of my vaccination status to every in-person meeting?

At your first in-person meeting your 2022 Membership Card will be marked to indicate proof of full vaccination status so that at future meetings you need only bring your 2022 Membership Card and your mask. Guests who have previously attended an in-person meeting will still need to show proof of vaccination status at subsequent meetings, since we do not keep records of their status.

Will coffee &/or tea be available in Wolfe Hall? If not, can I bring my own beverage in a spill proof container?

Sorry, not at this time.



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FAQ (cont)

Has Zoom registration changed?

No, there are no changes in the registration process – click the “Zoom” button and complete the registration as you have in the past. You’ll receive an email from Senior Scholars, via Zoom, containing the URL you need to click on to join the meeting.

I have lost my nametag? How can I obtain a replacement?

You can order a new nametag at [Replacement Nametag](#) for a \$10 fee. The nametag will be mailed to you.
