Infusion Fund Activities

Infusion Fund: Year 1

- \$9.3m in general operating support for 38 orgs
- \$867,000 for ASC operations
- \$833,000 for organizations & artists distributed through the ASC
- \$400,000 to 51 creative groups & non-profits through an open call
 - Provided access to unrestricted funding
- \$235,000 for Opportunity Fund pilot projects



Infusion Fund Activities

Infusion Fund: Year 2


- \$8.9m in general operating support for 38 orgs
- \$1.0m+ for organizations and artists distributed through the ASC
- \$950,000 for ASC operations
- \$600,000 via Opportunity Fund for 31 projects by artists & groups



Arts and Culture Plan



- Engaged global firm Lord Cultural Resources
 - Facilitate cultural plan with economic analysis and countywide public engagement.
- Guided by ~40-member community steering group
